REQUIREMENTS:

Eligible applicants must be:

- A senior in high school, graduating and planning to enroll in post-secondary education in the same calendar year the award is presented.
- A U.S. Citizen or eligible non-citizen under state residency statutes.
- An Arizona resident actively enrolled in the JAG program at the time of high school graduation and during the period of award presentation.
- Free of conviction of any second or subsequent alcohol or drug-related misdemeanor or felony in any state within the past academic year.

DUE DATE: APRIL 9TH

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Complete the Scholarship Application Cover Page (attached).
2. Include a brief cover letter describing your college and career plans.
3. Complete and submit an Essay (minimum 500 words) in response to the prompt: “The Environment and Me”. Specifically the Essay should:
 - a. Describe why the environment is important to you and your community
 - b. Define a problem/issue related to environmental health
 - c. Describe your plan for addressing this problem/issue (keeping in mind the key principles identified above)
4. Complete required steps or admittance to the College of your choice, as well as other financial aid applications (FAFSA, scholarships, etc.) *Reference completed steps in cover letter.*
5. Submit all required attachments (Essay, Transcript and verification of College acceptance and FAFSA submission) to the JAG Central Office:

****NOTE:** All essays submitted will be considered joint property of Jobs for Arizona’s Graduates, Inc., Republic Services, Inc. and the writer. Essays may be used in promotional material, websites, newsletters, etc.

AWARD: If awarded, JAG will release the \$1000 scholarship award directly to the college or institution at which the awardees are enrolled. Failure to enroll in the college or the institution where the funds will be released will result in the forfeiture of the award.

AWARD ANNOUNCEMENT: Scholarship winners will be announced at the Career Development Conference, in April. Award recipients will be asked to read their winning essay(s) during the Luncheon event. In addition, Scholarship Winners may be required to present their essay, along with a progress report during the Fall 2021 Republic Services Quarterly Meeting.
