This scholarship represents academic excellence, leadership and exceptional promise. This honor is intended to promote and encourage a multi-faceted experience designed to not only assist the financial needs of a college bound student but also to encourage participation in higher education, molding them into dynamic leaders with a commitment to service learning.

The *Dr. Oranté Jenkins Leadership in Education Scholarship* is offering a \$500 cash scholarship to a high school senior who has participated in JAG during their school career. It is our desire to help increase the number of students who are able to attend the colleges and universities of their choice — where they are poised to develop their academic skills and leadership talents. This scholarship may be utilized for any undergraduate course of study at any college or university. Each recipient must meet the regular academic requirements for admission to the college or university.

## Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- Be a senior in high school
- Have participated in JAG for at least one year
- Apply and be admitted to a college or university as a full-time student before disbursement
