

Cover Design

Description	Competitors will create a program cover design around the CDC's theme, <i>"Inspire, Influence, Impact"</i> to promote Jobs for America's Graduates. The winning cover design will be displayed at the JAG CDC event and used on JAG promotional materials.
Purpose	To demonstrate artistic, creative and imaginative abilities on a cover design used to promote Jobs for America's Graduates.
Eligibility & Entry	<p>All JAG students are eligible to enter, no limit per Chapter, one entry per student</p> <p>Participants must submit their entry for this competition on Headrush by the due date.</p> <p>This competition is pre-judged; the top 3 designs will be recognized at the CDC</p>

Rules	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Submissions are due by the deadline. 2. Designs should be either submitted as a high-resolution jpg. File on Headrush. <p>General guidelines are as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Submission must be 8"x11" edge-to-edge, in a vertical orientation b. Designs must be 2D on a white, flat surface; 3D designs will be disqualified c. Drawings must be freehand and original; Artificially generated design and clip art are not allowed d. Design must feature the CDC's theme: <i>"Inspire, Influence, Impact"</i> e. Design must also feature the event's details (name & date) f. School, chapter, names, initials, and/or any identifying symbols may NOT appear on the face of the entry.



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g. The following information must be printed on the back of the design or added to the subject line:

- i. Name of the student
 - ii. Name of their school and advisor
 - iii. Address and telephone number of the school
 - iv. Summary of the Design: What does the design mean to the student? Why did they choose this design?
3. Judging is based on how well the design relates to the essence of JAG, artistic representation, originality, overall appearance, the use
 4. Winners will be announced during the Awards Ceremony at the CDC.
