<p>Description</p>	<p>Chapters will create a school-wide/community event to educate and encourage youth wellbeing awareness. The project will not be intended to be a substitute for or to be relied upon as medical advice, diagnosis or treatment, but will be used to bring awareness to the community. Chapter will display pictures and a description of the event, and what led to the planning of the event, in a magazine (booklet) created by the JAG Chapter.</p>
<p>Purpose</p>	<p>To encourage chapter members to explore the importance of youth wellbeing, to educate, empower, and support their community by hosting a youth wellbeing awareness PBL project.</p>
<p>Eligibility & Entry</p>	<p>One entry per Chapter</p> <p>The chapter must register their competitor for this competition via the registration form by the registration date.</p> <p>Entry must be submitted to Headrush by the deadline.</p>
<p>Rules</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Chapter must register their competitors for this competition via the registration form before it closes. 2. The Chapter Scrapbook must plan and host a 1-day youth school/community wellness event 3. The Chapter will clearly communicate and display the project in an 8.5" x 11" magazine (booklet), no longer than 10 pages (20 front and back) 4. The front page must include the name of the YWA Project, the JAG Program name, and the Program's school. 5. Entry must include why this YWA Project was chosen 6. The YWA Project must be a creative event and capture the planning and execution of the event entirely. 7. Descriptions and pictures of activities must be included. 8. Entry must be 100% student created, including creation, pictures, and editing. If the event and magazine is not student created, the entry will be disqualified.
